COURSE SUMMARY

This course offers balanced training in reading, writing, speaking, and comprehending spoken Hindi. The *Devanagari* script is stressed in the early part of the semester. By the end of the course, students should be able to read and write a range of basic practical sentences and words in Hindi.

PREREQUISITES/PLACEMENT

Students should have basic knowledge of Hindi vowels and consonants.

MATERIALS

Required:

- One note book
- One eraser
- One pencil
- One water bottle
- One lunch box
- Hat for sun protection
- One glue stick.

REQUIREMENTS AND EXPECTATIONS

Class sessions and class activity will include regular written homework, listening exercises in and outside of class, in-class review of homework, oral drills, weekly quizzes or activity, dictations.
